

Describe the problem your organization will address, the root causes of this problem, and why it still exists.

Inequality from the perspective of where somebody is born, the following multinational financial injustice out of this reason produced so many refugees in the past, because of poverty, hunger, water shortages, climate issues, visa etc., that one of the solutions docutopia opens up is autonomous, selfcreated, ecosocial governance through the birthright to land, water and clean air, free housing & healthcare, support for single parents etc. with the help of an UBI+ individual swarm support. Multiple (digital) still separated networks are a part of it too, like unequal currencies in various states which have not yet agreed as people themselves to start with the same values for the future generations to inherit a healthy, peaceful earth as one.

Describe the specific approach your organization will take to solve the problem described above. Please include specific details of the activities your organization undertakes to help us understand what your work looks like.

Docutopia, the multitool platform will develop into a open source, super-app with self editable, multiple layers and interactive solutions to solve the described problems together with ecoheros as prosumers. It's vision is to invite people to go on from the metaverse into the multiverse back on the ground of mother earth, to it's springs, rivers, forrest, seas and so on, to take care of it, map it and share knowledges about it and organize together for everyone's benefit. A substancial ingriedient will be the consensus tool #wikelecta to have a transparent way of law/policy co-creation, a people proofed polls and petitions integration to start/process local, regional and (supra)national decisions within public hands from being born onwards.

Tell us about the people in the community you work with: who they are and how do they (or will they) interact with your organization?

I am grateful to know the founder of the collective essbare Stadt e.V.(edible city). It was founded more than 10 years ago and is the first collaboration with this name in whole Europe. Since then it grew as word, intention and initiative into a movement europe wide into the edible cities network with hubs world wide, collaborating on a global scale now. I see constructive solutions coming out of this connection and further interdisciplinary results to achieve as many SDG+ together as possible. To work with local, regional, national goverments, global institutions like "..for future", UN, worldbank, greenpeace etc. and digital, social, professional networks is planned too, to combine synergies, simplify burocracy and give everyone a voice.

How will the lives of the people in the community improve because of this work?

The live and work conditions of people in the community are going to be improved, because through the self-governance part of docutopia #wikelecta all are invited to get involved via direct votes, polls to co-create laws, legislations, policies and to decide decentral and sovereign together with their region where they live. It's outcome in forms of a cashcard with an unconditional basic income, free housing as well as free healthcare self-generates through mapping and co-creation of sustainable projects in circular production chains, transparent currencies equality together with peace/re and up-cycling progress protocols incl. QR, NFTs, IDs & free visas as a people proofed passport for human, children, animal, labor, water and landrights.

Describe your relationship to the community you work with and how they are involved in your organization's strategy and decision-making.

As mentioned already above, the inclusive, open-source multiverse of docutopia gives everyone the possibility for participating in decision-making as basic construct of a multi-governance sovereignty. Symbiotic synchronizable solutions will be achieved with docutopia's event mapping markers, whereas in the upcoming version 2.1. needs and offers, private, public, professional and volutary ones are matchable with each other automatically with hashtags. This feature extends the ability for each ecohero as prosumer within the community to collaborate in real time, hierachy-free, not only digital but also in reality to plant trees, coordinate urban gardens, social kitchens, free schools and kindergardens, repair cafes, fablabs, hackerspaces, arts, music, cultural and others events, projects as well as products. Docutopia's gamefication part will generate a surplus for all, as ecosocial DOcoins are minted directly from human to human onto each other cash card for services and products.

Describe why you are passionate about this work and community.

I am enthusiastic about the community of edible city networks, all native people I've met in my life so far and the project docutopia, because my perspective of a healthy future only is possible with a multicultural, visa-free, poverty free, UBI+ generation who will be able to survive in the times of extreme climate feedbacks and ressource scarcity by self-determination, self-governance, sovereignty and through "peacycling" actions. I foresee with the help of docutopia and it's next versions a shift into a transparent, socio-ecological economy from the people for the people co-creating, maintaining their living natural habitats as one species again, like all indigenous people still know how to do so. They are the best teachers who will guide humanity with their knowledges about fauna, flora, the elements and show us peacefully our responsibility for our unique planet at it's critical stage of biodiversity and health. Therefore I strongly believe to bring symbiosis back with docutopia.

Share one or two examples which demonstrate your leadership and ability to build and guide an organization towards the achievement of its strategic goals and priorities.

I was leader of a group for several years as teenager, eventhough the little ones from the scouts where about the same age as I was, it definetly shaped my view on group dynamics. I was respecting everyone's opinion, individuality, unique ways of qualities and weaknesses. That helped me to give them the same amount of respect as it was given from my leaders before to me. I see leading or teaching as a work of collaboration and co-creation where learning is a part of teaching too, I remember from this past experiences within a group how it is like to feel accepted as human. That is what I would love to strenghten with the project docutopia as well, that everybody feels acceptance, gets rewarded for ecosocial work and is getting safed without conditions by physical, mental and financial support.

Imagine a future where people of all races have equal opportunity to thrive. How did your vision help lead to this future? The long-term outcome I dream of is that everyone has equal opportunities to prosper in live, no matter where, who and from what background. Additionally to equal rights, I would love to be a part of the next evolutionary step of humanity from the digital information age into a multiversal peacycling era with free education, healthcare & visa, UBI, transparent economical, self-governed structures for future generations to walk proudly in our footsteps. If docutopia as a multimap, is getting integrated as well by as many other, already existing social, professional and ecological networks as possible, it has the potential to make everybodys voices heard, recognized and visible, if they choose to join the multiverse. Together it reconstructs & guides communities into a paradise of healthy nature with individual freedom of choice, veto power & direct consensual decisions from all for all. An equal people's global village is going to be reality, when docutopia's next versions are live.

Please describe how your work resolves the root cause problems – and not only manages the symptoms – of the system your work addresses.

Ecological, social, political & economical cartography can be implemented in all different sections of life, cultures, sciences, businesses, institutions, goverments and NGO's with docutopia. The key components for successfully combing these parts and reaching all SDG's are on the one side, political decisions amongst all nations on our planet which urgently need to be made. They will be intrinsically implemented within docutopia's wikelecta function. On the other side ecological, educational as well as economical integrity and transparency is crucial. People's proofed product journalism, transparent media & banking sector map layers will soon solve these issues. Creating possibilities with docutopia's future versions to invite public institutions for the benefit of the environment and the people to be part of the solution by self-created, interactive, real-time map layers as well as NFT-IDI born certificates to create an UBI DO-cashcard to end poverty once and for ever is the way.

Describe this organization's approach to changing the same system you are looking to address and why you chose them as a strong example.

World coin is trying to solve poverty by implementing an UBI as docutopia will aim for too besides of other goals. It's approach is a bit different due to the fact that world id and world coin is scanning the eyeballs of it's prosumers and has nothing to do with political, ecological, educational or mapping interactions as docutopia has. Anyhow it is a strong example and a collaboration with this network and other social, educational, professional and ecological networks are very welcome in the future. A couple of other potential partners are wikipedia, openstreetmap, transformap, umap, telegram, facebook, github, reddit, couch surfing, car sharing, linked in, neighbours and many more.

How has your work been informed by this organization and how does your own work further advance systemic change?

My work was not informed by these organizations mentioned above, because docutopia stems from it's original idea of the transparent restaurant in the year 2012 when most of these organizations were not operating or I was not informed about their purpose yet. My work will advance systemic change by offering opportunities for real people around the planet, including natives, artists, developers, political parties within and beyond the UN and especially young people with a long term perspective to join a trustworthy seed of an organization to achieve all SDG's together united as one.

Describe this organization's approach to changing the same system you are looking to address and why you chose them as a strong example.

Being autonomous in terms of food or at least partly with the help of CSA's, urban gardening, collective planting of fruitforests and sharing knowledges, seeds as well as helping nature coming back into the city, it's a strong example how to lay a foundation for sustainable solutions. As an essential layer of cartography, edible plants are the inspiration from which grew the part of docutopia to invite "ecoheros" to take care of their surrounding and even earning in the nearby future something with it. The UBI based on natural, replantable resources came into my mind thanks to edible city. A drinkable city as one map layer of clean & fresh water sources will be a part of docutopia's approach to sovereign land & water rights for all people.
